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Handling, Storage, Disposal, Spill Clean Up



Handling precautions:	Read product label and instruction leaflet prior to use. Wear protective clothing such as overalls and gloves when preparing the vaccine.
Handling practices:	After administration of the vaccine remove protective clothing and wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum or using tobacco.
Storage:	Store in closed original container in a refrigerator at 2° to 8°C. Do not freeze. Note: Product has a short shelf life once reconstituted as gel.
Disposal:	Preferably dispose of the product by use. Wrap any remaining product in paper and dispose by incineration, or seal waste product in plastic and dispose in an appropriate garbage system. The vaccine should be considered a biohazard to poultry as it contains live oocysts and disposal should avoid the potential risk of spread to non-vaccinated birds.
Spill Clean Up:	Wrap material with inert material such as paper and seal in plastic prior to garbage disposal. Use a broad-spectrum Disinfectant to clear any product residue from surfaces. Any product spillage on floor surfaces becomes a slippery hazard.

First Aid Measures

Inhalation:	Significant inhalation exposure is considered to be highly unlikely. Not an irritant.
Ingestion:	If product is swallowed do NOT induce vomiting, wash mouth with water and give some water to drink. Seek medical advice if concerned.
Self-Injection:	Not applicable.
Skin Contact:	Flush with lukewarm gently flowing water for 5 minutes or until product is removed.
Eye Contact:	No effects expected. If irritation does occur, flush contaminated eye(s) with lukewarm gently flowing water for 5 minutes or until product is removed. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do.
