<b>Hazard classifications:</b>	<b>Not classified as Hazardous according to the Hazardous Substances (Classification) Regulations. Does not trigger hazard thresholds.</b> Not a Dangerous Good according to IATA or NZTA.

<b>Storage statements:</b>	None allocated. This product does not have HSNO storage requirements.
<b>Disposal statements:</b>	Not allocated. Disposal in general waste once product is used. Unused product should be disposed as biological waste.
<b>Other hazards:</b>	Accidental needle stick injuries (self-injection) are a risk when administering the vaccine to Poultry.

<b>Extinguishing media and methods:</b>	Use extinguishing media suitable to burning materials such as water, foam, dry agent (CO <sub>2</sub> ), sand or dolomite.
<b>HAZCHEM code:</b>	1T (recommended)
<b>Special protective equipment and Precautions:</b>	Wear self-contained breathing apparatus.

<b>Handling precautions:</b>	Read product label and instruction leaflet prior to use. Wear protective clothing such as overalls and gloves when mixing and administering the vaccine.
<b>Handling practices:</b>	After administration of the vaccine remove protective clothing and wash hands before eating, drinking, chewing gum or using tobacco.
<b>Storage:</b>	Store in closed original container in a refrigerator at 2° to 8°C. Do not freeze.
<b>Disposal:</b>	Avoid disposal of unused vaccine it is best to use the product. Neutralize vaccine container and remaining contents in a Chlorine Bleach solution prior to wrapping with paper and disposing in an appropriate garbage system. The vaccine should be considered a biohazard to poultry as it contains a live virus culture and disposal should avoid the potential risk of spread to non-vaccinated birds.
<b>Spill Clean Up:</b>	Absorb or wrap material with inert material such as paper and rags and neutralize with Chlorine Bleach prior to garbage disposal.

First Aid Measures	
<b>Inhalation:</b>	Significant inhalation exposure is considered to be highly unlikely.
<b>Ingestion:</b>	If product is swallowed do NOT induce vomiting, wash mouth with water and give some water to drink. Seek medical advice if concerned.
<b>Self-Injection:</b>	In the case of accidental injection, treat the wound as a contaminated puncture wound. Bleeding if present from the puncture wound should be encouraged as an aid to draw vaccine out, gently squeeze the wound with an absorbent tissue for a minute. Then wash the wound site with warm water and dry before applying a sterile dressing. Seek medical advice, particularly if the wound site swells or discomfort suggests tissue damage to any part of the hand (or body). Bacterial contamination of the wound site and Tetanus infections are possible risks following accidental needle stick injuries.
<b>Skin Contact:</b>	Flush with lukewarm gently flowing water for 5 minutes or until product is removed.
<b>Eye Contact:</b>	No effects expected. If irritation does occur, flush contaminated eye(s) with lukewarm gently flowing water for 5 minutes or until product is removed. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do.
